12.1 LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

12.1. 1 CONTROL COMMITTEE / INTERNATIONAL REFEREES:

Transportation is foreseen by car and will be arranged by the Guides.

12. 1. 2 TEAMS:

Transfer from/to hotel, as well as local transportation from/to the competition hall is foreseen by bus.

12.2 TRANSPORT FROM POLAND TO DENMARK

Transfer from Poland to Denmark for qualified teams as well as officials and international referees is foreseen by charter flight.



13. LAUNDRY

The Organizer is bound to provide and bear the cost for laundry of the sport uniforms of the teams after each match. The items are: 1 set of playing shirts, shorts and socks of each player. The cleaned items will be delivered back to the delegations the day after and before the start of the matches.

14. MEALS

14.1 CONTROL COMMITTEE/ INTERNATIONAL REFEREES:

The CEV Officials order their meals from the menu in the hotel's restaurant. Time for lunch and dinner will be arranged by themselves in accordance with their duties.

14.2 TEAMS:

Athletes will be guaranteed three basic meals a day in the hotel's restaurant, beginning with lunch on the day of arrival and ending with breakfast on the day of departure. Teams receive an additional snacks in the hotel on each match day (snack means tea/ coffee/ sandwiches/ fruits/ cakes).

15. FINANCIAL MATTERS INCLUSIVE EXPENSES COVERED BY THE ORGANIZERS

15.1 Participation Fee

For each TEAM QUALIFIED for the FINAL ROUND the respective National Federation shall forward, at the latest 30 days before the start of the competition, a participation fee, amounting to **700.- EURO** into the bank account of the CEV.

15.2 International Transportation

For the FINAL ROUND, each team shall only bear its own return travelling costs to the official venue of arrival/departure indicated by the organizing Federation.



All travel expenses within the hosting country, i.e. transportation from this central venue to the other competition sites - and back - shall be borne by the National Federation organizing the final round.

15.3 ACCOMMODATION

For the FINAL ROUND, the organizing National Federation bear the hotel (good category) and food costs for each team delegation as defined in Chapter 1 art. 2.3 of Regulations, not including the referee possibly appointed by the ERC, for a period starting two days before the beginning of the competition and ending one day after the closing of the final phase.

16. EXTRA PERSONS COSTS

Extra cost for each additional person in 200 EUR/per day, payable in cash upon arrival to the Organizer.

17. MEDICAL MATTERS AND ANTI – DOPING CONTROL

17.1 FIRST AID

First Aid will be provided in the competition hall during the competition.

17.2 ANTI – DOPING CONTROL

Anti-Doping control must be conducted under the supervision of the CEV Medical Delegate in accordance with the FIVB Medical Regulations.

Anti-Doping controls may be conducted at any time by WADA according to the agreement between WADA and CEV.

18. PRESS MATTERS

All players are kindly requested to cooperate with media representatives.



All players have to leave the playing area through the mixed zone, where they should be available for interviews.

Participation in the official press conference 10 minutes after the match is mandatory for head coach and the team captain of both teams.

19. ENTRY VISAS

It is the visiting teams' responsibilities to fulfill in due time the necessary formalities to obtain the visa to enter the territory of Denmark and Poland.

Each visiting team which needs visa for its delegation member(s) must send their request for invitation including the list of person(s) and passport numbers to the hosting team if possible no later than 30 days before the first/next match for which they have been drawn or qualified for respectively no later than 24 hours after the qualification of both opponents to a specific round.
